

Boys State has given tens of thousands of young Kansans a powerful introduction to civic responsibility. Boys State strengthens confidence, inspires leadership, builds bonds of friendship and erases prejudice — all in a safe, open and welcoming environment. This is an opportunity to pass the torch of leadership to the next generation.

Program Fees. The total fee for the 2021 session of Kansas Boys State is \$350. In most situations, a delegate or their family pays \$50 and a sponsoring organization pays the remaining \$300. Both fees must accompany the completed registration.

Delegate Qualifications

For 2021, sophomores (on an available space basis), juniors and seniors will be eligible to attend Kansas Boys State. These classifications are based on the 2020-21 school year.



Why attend Kansas Boys State?

The best teacher is often experience. Learning leadership in the classroom is often too theoretical. Boys State is a practical opportunity to learn leadership skills through role-play civic exercises.

Colleges and universities recognize Boys State delegates as advanced and dedicated young men. For this reason, the Boys State college fair attracts top-tier schools who recruit Boys State participants.

Finally, Boys State is simply fun. Delegates will form lasting friendships. The connections made with other Boys State attendees will last a lifetime,

and provide social and professional benefits for years to come.

Sending a young man to Boys State is a two-fold investment. First, it is an investment in a young man with plans for college and beyond. It is also an investment in the future of your community, state and nation.

After the registration has been processed, delegates will receive links via e-mail to several online packet files.

These files explain what to bring to the session, elected and appointed offices and a schedule of day-to-day activities. Carefully studying this information will help delegates benefit fully from their Boys State
