### **Scholarships**

#### Samsung Scholarship

Eligible participants can apply for a Samsung scholarship through The American Legion. Meant to show appreciation for U.S. veterans who came to South Korea's aid during its struggle against communist forces in the Korean War, the Samsung Corporation endowed a \$5 million scholarship fund through the American Legion. Winners are selected according to academic record, involvement in school and community service.

Scholarship applications are submitted online and due by 11:59 p.m. on June 2, 2024.

- Ten National Scholars receive \$10,000 each (two from each region)
- Ten National Runners-Up receive \$5,000 each (two from each region)
- One Department (State) finalist will be awarded
   a \$1.250 scholarship



### WHAT IS BOYS STATE?

It is also an opportunity to gain pride and respect for government, and the price paid by veterans to preserve democracy.

### FEES

The fee for Kansas Boys State is \$375. This primarily pays for a week of food & lodging. In most situations a delegate or their family pays \$50, and a sponsoring organization pays the remaining \$325.

### **College Credit Available**

Three hours of college credit can be earned by successfully completing Boys State. There is an additional fee, payable to K-State, but the \$366 fee is significantly less than regular tuition. Those interested do not have to be enrolled at K-State; the credit is transferable. The course (POLSC 110) will be taught by Dr. Nate Birkhead. Attending Boys State will fulfill part of the course requirements with additional course work assigned by the instructor. The course work will be due in the weeks following Boys State. Enrollment will be handled through your school guidance counselor.

### **College and Career Fair**

Universities, colleges, technical, vocational schools, law enforcement, military academies, and the Kansas National Guard attend the College and Career Fair. Delegates can communicate directly with admissions personnel and learn more about programs and scholarship opportunities. More than 30 institutions attended in 2023.
